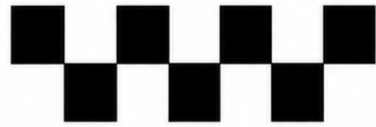
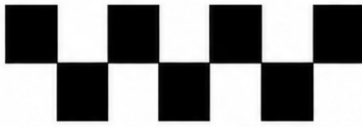

- **Welcome guests from the Cardinal Virginians, Over-the-Mountain, Capitol and the Hoosier Cruisers chapters. We're happy you joined us!**
- The **"Coffee Station"** will be our information location. It will be located under the tents around sites 29-30. Please check your emails each morning for schedule changes/updates. We will also try to list the changes at the "Coffee Station" on a marker boards.
- Remember some of our activities will be **weather dependent**.
- **"The Shirt Shop"** will be open at the registration building on Friday & Saturday. Emily will have a variety of shirts to purchase..."Camping", "Pocono" and "Penn Coachmen". Stop in and see all the different designs she has available. You can also bring a plain white shirt to "tie dye" at "The Shirt Shop" with Emily's instructions. Hours will be posted on the door. - **Kleen Tank** will be attending our rally this year. If you haven't had your tanks cleaned recently, we highly recommend it. Eric Kreiser will be with us for the entire rally. He only charges \$250. A separate email was sent out for early sign-ups. He will also be holding a seminar on Friday...great information!
- We will have free time to ride bikes, scooters, walk, etc. on the track. We will not know when until we get there...TBA.
- We will also be escorted in our own cars to drive 2-3 laps around the track, behind a "pace car"...Day and time...TBA.

These are our “Early Bird Days.” We will be working on getting everyone parked. Please listen to the “Parking Team”. The track parking was not laid out like a typical campground. Park 3 feet and parallel to the passengers side line. Then everyone will be able to open their slides and awnings.



- ♦ 9am-5pm Registration is open. Enter at GATE #1...When you arrive, STOP at the Guard Shack. He will instruct you regarding which side of the tunnel to go under. Big rigs must use the left side going in. Do not enter any tunnel without the guard’s directions.
- ♦ After you go under the tunnel, the Penn Coachmen signs will direct you to pull into the “Registration Building.” (Second building on your right). Signs, flags, and balloons should show you the way. You will park there, come in and pay the balance of the rally, pick up any info we have and sign up for games & crafts.
- ♦ Track Tours: Sign up for track tours at registration or coffee tent.
- ♦ Raffle tickets will be sold at registration and coffee station for the “Hand-Knitted U.S. Flag” made by Patti Mandik. All proceeds will go to the Mattioli Foundation.
- ♦ We will not have any planned activities these days. (9th & 10th)
- ♦ If the weather permits in the evenings we will get together for “social time.” Bring your chair and beverage and join in the group by the tents. *Campfires are permitted. (rings on site)*
